Short Answer: YES

- You need documentation that you were made aware of the document
- You need a timestamp to track timelines for the document (i.e. if you are filing a grievance, you need the date it was received in writing)
- If you disagree with the content, you may sign the document this way:

Signature: John Doe Date: 02/25/2022

I am signing this document for record of signature only, I do not agree with the contents of the material.
